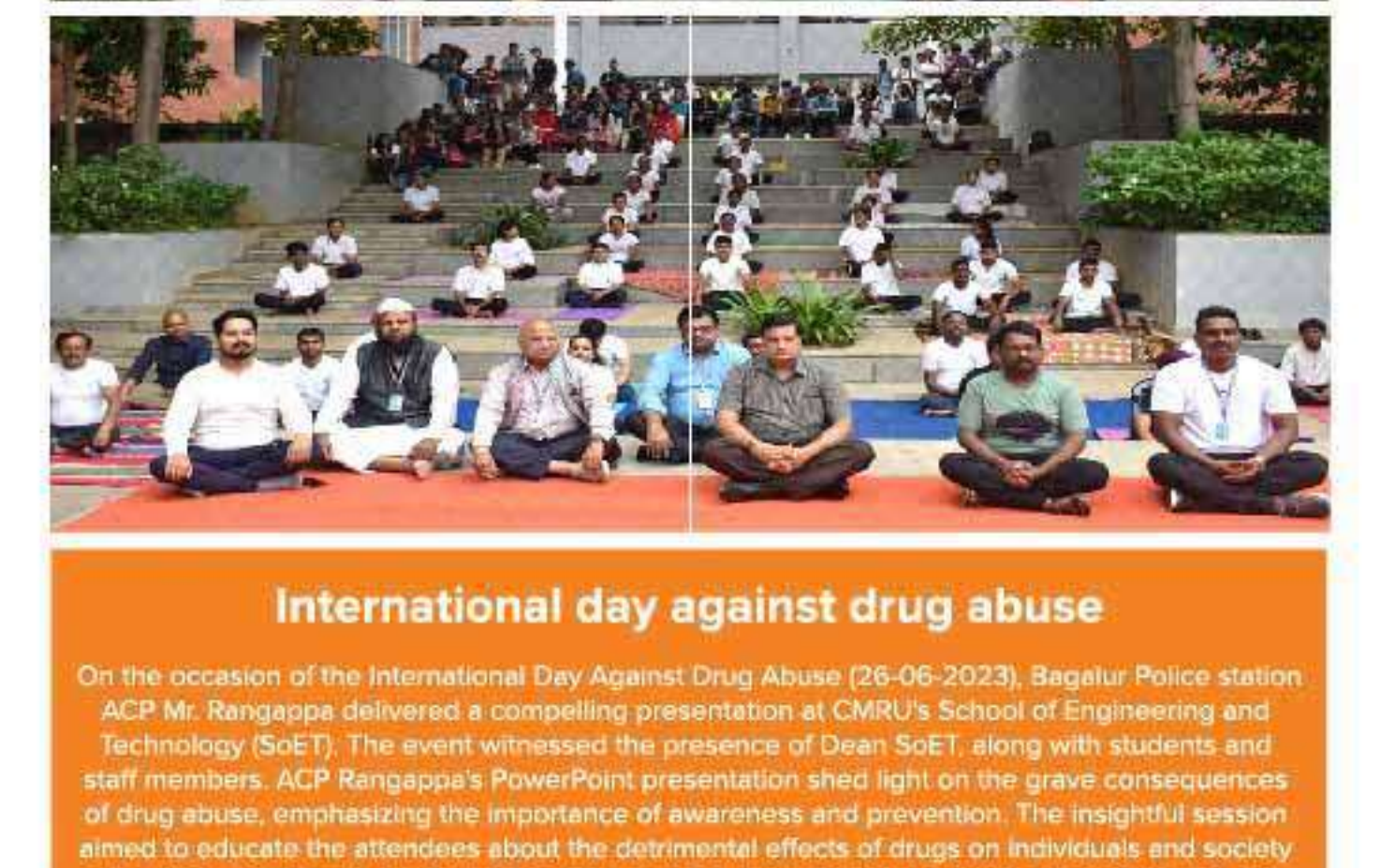


**Lt. Gen. C.A Krishnan**

**Demystifying Authorship in Evolving Copyright Law**  
**Prof. Anirban Mazumdar**  
 Date: 9th May, 2023



The CMRU-KSCST IP Cell orchestrated a thought-provoking webinar on the 9th of May in 2023, delving into the intricate theme of "Demystifying Authorship in Evolving Copyright Law." The highlight of this illuminating event was the distinguished presence of Professor Anirban Mazumdar, an academic luminary with a rich educational journey. Prof. Mazumdar, an alumnus of Calcutta University, attained his LL.B. from Burdwan University, LL.M. from the National Law School of India University in Bangalore, M.Phil. from the National University of Juridical Sciences, Calcutta, and a Ph.D. from the same institution.

In his illustrious career, Professor Mazumdar has been imparting his profound knowledge in the domains of Intellectual Property (IP) and Information Technology (IT) law at both undergraduate and graduate levels since 2003. His expertise extends across areas such as copyright, patent, and IT law, with his doctoral thesis focusing on Database Copyright Protection. Beyond the borders of India, Prof. Mazumdar has served as a Visiting Scholar at prestigious institutions such as Touro Law School, New York University, and Cardiff University. He was also honored as a Tel Aviv University Cegla Scholar.

Professor Mazumdar's contributions to the field are not limited to academia; he has penned numerous essays on copyright law for national and international publications. His scholarly work extends to the publication of the book titled "Database Law: Indian Perspective" by Springer. Prof. Mazumdar has taken the lead in various significant projects, including the UGC's "Patent Prosecution Challenges in Biotechnology Related Inventions" initiative and the West Bengal Judicial Academy Project on "Judicial Trained in Cases Related to Cyber Crime with special reference to West Bengal." Additionally, he has lent his expertise to the Expert Committee on Utility Model, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce, Government of India, and serves as a member of the Copyright Enforcement Advisory Council. Notably, Prof. Mazumdar also played a pivotal role in coordinating the NUJS MHRD IPR Chair from 2014 to 2019.

During the webinar, Professor Mazumdar commenced by shedding light on the complexities of identifying the authorship of projects generated by AI bots in contrast to those produced by students. He tackled the critical question of rightful ownership and credit attribution for AI-generated works. Furthermore, he elucidated the criteria for recognizing an author and provided valuable insights into the expectations from an author in the context of copyright.

The historical evolution of copyright law, dating back to the Statute of Anne in 1710, was meticulously decoded by Prof. Mazumdar. His lecture seamlessly navigated through the perspectives of UK legislations and Indian statutory approaches, elucidating the essential elements that define an author and the means to identify one's creative work.

A particular highlight of the lecture was the in-depth exploration of the unique case of spell check in relation to the Copyright, Designs, and Patents Act of 1988, underscoring its profound implications in contemporary copyright law.

Professor Anirban Mazumdar's insightful presentation during the webinar was a testament to his erudition and deep understanding of copyright law, leaving attendees enriched with knowledge and a heightened appreciation for the nuances of authorship in the evolving landscape of copyright legislation.
