Only original and unpublished work will be accepted. The total length of the paper should not exceed Eight (08) A4 size pages including references and appendices. If it exceeds that, an extra page fee will be applicable based on approval. All the accepted papers will be published in the proceedings of the International Conference with an ISBN No. and in the abstracts of the papers presented at the Conference.
